

Nomination for Classis Vice President

We are seeking nominees for the officer of the Vice President of the Holland Classis. Because of our unique situation wherein we do not have any nominees at this time, the Executive committee has voted to receive candidate names that are either elder or minister.

The person being nominated needs to give her or his consent to have her or his name on the ballot. It is preferred that the nominee give permission before the person's name is submitted. The person needs to be an elder in one of our classis churches or a minister who is a member of the Holland Classis. Elders need to be active, confessing members of a Holland Classis Church, but do not need to be currently serving on the consistory.

The Classis Coordinator will follow up on the nomination to confirm the person's willingness and qualifications. Also, to discuss the position and address questions a candidate may have.

Responsibilities of Vice President

The president shall

1. Call special sessions of the Classis.
2. Approve the order of service and participants for ordination and installation services.
3. Preside at all sessions of the Classis. The right to vote in all matters before the classis is inherent in the office of president. The president does not need to be designated as an elder delegate in order to have the right to vote.
4. Represent the Classis (or designate a representative) at all events and occasions that require official representation.
5. Decide all questions of order according to the *Classis of Holland Bylaws*, the *RCA Book of Church Order*, and the current edition of *Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised*.
6. The president chairs the Executive Committee and is an ex-officio member of all Classis committees (except Nominations).

B. The vice president shall

1. Preside at sessions of the Classis in the absence of the president.
2. Assume the duties of the office of the president in the event the office should become vacant.
3. The vice-president is a member of the Executive Committee and is an ex-officio member of all Classis committees (except Nominations).
